The Winnersh Community Centre and Allnatt Pavilion (at Bearwood Recreation Ground) have served the community well for half a century. They have been well maintained but are in need of significant upgrade or replacement to bring them up to modern standards. We also want to ensure they are energy efficient and can offer more attractive and flexible spaces for a wider range of activities.



In deciding whether to upgrade or replace the buildings we need to know what type of activities and services our community require. We want our offering to be enticing enough for people to want to spend time at our facilities, whether that is before, during or after any groups or classes you may attend. So, for example, a café to meet up with family and friends, perhaps after dropping children at the local school or just enjoying a day in the park.

To help us understand and create a plan for the facilities we would like to hear your suggestions, however diverse they may be, so we have created a questionnaire so that you can easily tell us what you really want.

Black boxes no longer used for recycling

From 4th October 2021 **Wokingham Borough Council** will no longer collect recycling from the old black boxes however there will be a short grace period to ensure all residents are notified and prepared for this change. After this time the council and its contractor Veolia will only be collecting recycling from the green waterproof recycling bags. Residents have been doing a great job repurposing and rehoming their old black recycling boxes.



There is a significant carbon and financial cost of collecting these boxes. Therefore, the council has reviewed its plans to collect these, as it would have cost about £100,000. The decision not to collect the old black boxes is in part due to the number of residents embracing the importance of repurposing their boxes.
