The role

No specific governance experience is essential. However, we would particularly welcome nominations from people with skills or experience in education policy and curriculum, finance, recruitment, performance and inspection and being a chair of a board or committee.

You will be provided with training. This is delivered by Wokingham Borough Council or through the [National Governance Association](#). This includes online learning for other sectors and types of work. In addition, you will be assigned a mentor to support you and help you as you learn the ropes.

As a governor you will gain skills you may not otherwise acquire and get a wider perspective on a key part of your community. Most importantly, you will get the satisfaction of knowing that you are helping to make a difference in the education of the children who attend Winnersh Primary school
