# **October 2023 weather summary**

#### Wetter, milder and sunnier than normal.

Rainfall: 112.3mm (145% of normal).

Reasonably dry first 10 days, but then turning wet and cyclonic. The rainfall total of 112.3mm was only the highest since 2020, but the 17<sup>th</sup> wettest since 1921, with 6 wetter Octobers since 2000. It was also the wettest 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the month since 2000.

The wettest day was 19.5mm on 19<sup>th</sup>, with 5.6mm falling in 1 hour that day.

The highest rainfall rate was 91mm/hr at 09:20hr on 29<sup>th</sup> when 5.0mm fell in 1 hour.

The number of rain days (0.2mm or more), were 17 (1 more than average) and there have been 9 Octobers with a higher number of days since 2000. The number of wet days (1.0mm or more) was 14 days (3 more than normal), and there have been 8 Octobers with a higher number of days since 2000.

## Temperature:

The **mean maxima** were 16.9c (+1.6 above normal), and the 9<sup>th</sup> mildest since 1921.

The highest temperature recorded was 23.7c on 9<sup>th</sup>. This was the 14<sup>th</sup> highest temperature recorded in October since at least 1921. There were 6 days at 20c or more, the highest since at least 1981, equal to 1995.

The lowest maximum temperature was 11.1c on 15<sup>th</sup>, and the lowest since 2019.

The mean minima were 13.1c (+2.9c), and the 6<sup>th</sup> mildest since at least 1921 (102 years).

The 'coldest night' was -0.4c on 16<sup>th</sup>, this was the first in October since 2019. It was also the first air frost since 8<sup>th</sup> April, making it 190 nights frost-free.

The **mean temperature** 13.2c (+1.7c above normal) and this was the **6**<sup>th</sup> **mildest** since at least 1921. All except 1921 are since 1995.

There were 2 ground frosts and lowest grass minimum recorded was -3.3c (21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>). The last grass frost was on 20<sup>th</sup> May, and the first on 15<sup>th</sup> October making it 147 nights frost-free.

## Sunshine: 134.2 hours (118% of normal)

Despite such a wet month it was sunnier than average and the 5<sup>th</sup> sunniest this millennium, and the 7<sup>th</sup> sunniest since in the past 32 years. There were 4 days that were sunless day ( about a 1 day less than normal).

The sunniest day was 9.3 hours (15<sup>th</sup>), which was the highest total for the 15<sup>th</sup> or later in the month since 2011.

Thunder; there were 1 day with thunder heard.

Hail; there were 0 day with hail (<5mm).

Snow falling 0 days with snow falling. Snow lying at 0900 GMT 0 days.

Fog; at the 0900am observation there were 0 days with fog observed.

## Storms

STORM Babet impacted the UK between 18<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> October. High rainfall totals were the biggest influence with 38.4mm over the 4 day period and 32.4mm over the first 48 hours,

Wind gusts 50km/hr or more; 0 days reached this criteria.


