## 5. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The committee considered the following planning applications:

i) Application Number: 232382

**Site Address:** 48 Robin Hood Lane, Winnersh, Wokingham, RG41 5NQ **Proposal:** Application to vary condition 3 of planning consent 230798 for the proposed erection of a single storey front extension following demolition of the existing single storey front extension, a first floor side extension and a single storey rear extension with 2 no. lantern rooflights following demolition of existing single storey rear extension and conservatory, plus changes to the existing roof form with the creation of part dormers following removal of existing front and rear

dormers, conversion of a garage to habitable accommodation and changes to fenestration. Condition 3 refers to external materials and the variation is to allow the changes to the colour of the proposed roof tile, windows, soffits and fascia's (part retrospective).

ii) Application Number: 232509

**Site Address:** 15 Laburnum Road, Winnersh, Wokingham, RG41 5XL **Proposal:** Householder application for the proposed erection of first floor side extension, plus changes to existing fenestration, following the conversion of existing garage to form habitable space.

The committee have noted there is an additional live application linked to the address - 232349. The Committee would like to ensure the impact on both applications are considered.

iii) Application Number: 231919

**Site Address:** 565 Reading Road, Winnersh, Wokingham, RG41 5HJ **Proposal:** Householder application for the proposed erection of a two-storey side extension following conversion of existing garage to create habitable accommodation, single storey rear extension plus changes to fenestration to include 1no, dormer to the rear.

Site Address: Land located to the east of Watmore Lane/Maidensfield,

Winnersh, RG41

**Proposal:** Outline application with access to be considered for the proposed erection of 111 dwellings and infrastructure all other matters (Appearance,

Landscaping, Layout and Scale) to be reserved

The committee wish to object on the same grounds as the previous applications. The reduction of dwellings doesn't address the committee's previous concerns. Nothing has changed regarding the road layouts and infrastructure. The increased traffic from the development is a concern especially as this is an access road which is incredibly narrow and therefore unsuitable for this level of development. Two schools are in the near location to the main access of Maidensfield. The increased traffic will have a detrimental impact on road safety. The previous points raised about the increase of noise and pollution have also not been addressed. Winnersh Parish Council stand by their previous objection.

**Site Address:** 23 Grovelands Avenue, Winnersh, Wokingham, RG41 5JU **Proposal:** Householder application for the proposed part single part 2 storey side/rear extensions with first floor Juliet balcony, single storey front extension to create porch. Raising of the roof to create habitable accommodation along with the insertion of front dormers to include changes to fenestration following demolition of the existing conservatory, garage and store.
